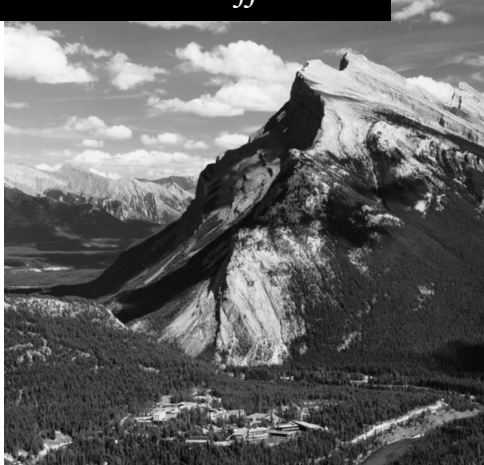


The Banff Centre

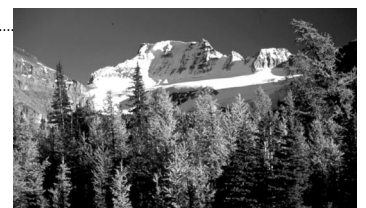
Leadership Development
